<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>"...Despite efforts to increase student enrollment over the past ten years, the student population has continued to decline, and is now down to 231 students"</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Previous administrations capped Freshman class enrollment.• <u>No</u> parent or alumni communications have occurred stating there was an enrollment problem.• <u>No</u> parent or alumni communication occurred about an Archdiocesan effort to increase enrollment.• Did you, your family or friends ever hear of any activities sponsored by the Archdiocese to help Daniel Murphy?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>"...A further decline in enrollment would have resulted in the cutting back of the curriculum, negatively impacting the school's ability to offer a quality education to the students. "</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Daniel Murphy parents voted to change the current tuition structure; which will bring an additional surplus of \$140,000 – with no Archdiocesan subsidy needed.• The school is and has been financially sound.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>"...This prospect, combined with the severe financial challenges now facing the archdiocese, accelerated the decision to close the school in 2008."</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Cardinal promised that no schools or parishes would be sold to pay for the child abuse lawsuit settlement.
